

Contract awarded to develop Metro depot


First phase (Uttara North to Agargaon) to complete in Dec 2019

Second phase (Agargaon to Motijheel) to complete in Dec 2020

Capacity: 60,000 passengers an hour

7 mega projects gaining pace

PAIRA DEEP-SEA PORT

Feasibility study for Paira deep-sea port submitted

The port starts this year by facilitating bulk ships in outer anchorage; constructions in 19 components

Full completion by 2023

China, UK, Belgium, Netherlands, Denmark & India submitted financing-development proposals

PROGRESS

All preparatory works for two unit 2,400mw NPP to complete this year

Final finance agreement with Russia this month

Construction of VVER 1200 reactor begins in 2017; plant to begin operation in 2022

Jajira approach road 65%

Mawa approach road 73%


Bridge & River training 21%

RAMPAL COAL POWER




PROGRESS

Indian company Bhel has been awarded contract in March to build the plant within 30 months (2018)

LNG TERMINAL




PROGRESS

Contract signed with US firm Excelerate to build a floating terminal in Maheshkhali in two years

Govt to import LNG equivalent to 500mmcf gas per day from Qatar from 2017

Construction of pipeline to transmit LNG to national grid in progress

1,500-acre site being developed amid difficulties

Project consultant being appointed; contractors being appointed for preparatory works

The 1,200mw project will be completed in 2022




